

Lesson 6 – Game with all Students

1. Play a draw game just like a regular club draw.
 - Temporary tags for students will be in the draw room.
 - Students will set up rinks
 - Students will draw positions, lead to third.
 - Helpers will play skips.
 - Coaches will watch and advise students without interrupting the flow of the game.
 - To prevent long delays, coaches will guide students in the head to help them determine shot bowls or if measuring is required.
 - Coaches or helpers will do all measuring.
2. 5 mins. - Warm down - end by asking if there are any questions. Remind students to wipe off their bowls and return them to the correct box. Tell them this is their last lesson and if they wish to continue they need to join the club.
3. Explain that now they are graduate novice bowlers. When they join the club, they can participate in all club functions. Encourage them to come to any of the draws, competitions, social events and other activities. Mention that draw play starts at 9:15am and 1:15pm therefore they should be at the club at least 15 minutes early. Remind them where the sign up sheets are and that they will receive weekly Monday Messages by email or they can read them on the bulletin board.
4. Have students come to the sign up table in the clubhouse.

Join the new bowlers for tea, coffee, juice and cookies after the lesson.
