CONDITIONS OF PLAY

The Laws of the Sport Crystal Mark 4th Edition 2022 Edition will be followed with the following additions:

1. Dress will be casual.
2. Players will flip a coin to determine who will deliver the Jack and first bowl.
3. The games will be 14 ends.
4. Each player will deliver 4 bowls.
5. Scoring will be – The bowl closet to the Jack is worth 3 points, next closet 2 points and the next closet 1 point. At the end of 14 ends, the total of points need to be 84. The player with the most points will be declared the winner of the game and game points will be awarded as 3 points for first place, 2 points for seconds place and 1 point for third place. If there is a tie game, the points for the respective players will be added and then divided i.e. second and third place tie – $2 + 1 = 3 / 2 = 1.5$ each.
6. Each person is responsible for finding their own spare. **Only 1 spare** will be allowed per session. If no spare appears, remaining players play each other for winning game points (1st - 3 points, 2nd - 2 points). They will also receive the average of points scored by 1st and 2nd place players. The defaulting player will receive 0 points.
7. IN THE FINAL GAME: NO SPARES are allowed in the top three positions except for a prior commitment to tournament play or inter-club play. **This must be passed by the league coordinator.**
8. If the Jack is improperly delivered once by all players, it is placed 2 metres from the front ditch and on the centre line (also known as the T).
9. If the Jack is knocked out of bounds, the end is dead and each player shall receive 2 points. The next end shall take the same order of play as the previous end. If the Jack goes into the ditch, play continues with the toucher removed. Touchers do not factor into play. They will be considered dead bowls.
10. Movement of players – each player may visit the Head after delivery of their third and fourth bowls.
11. Score cards are to be initialed all players and returned to sunroom to allow for the Games Committee to update the standings. The updated standings will be posted on the Games board and on the Club calendar.
12. Games must be played on the scheduled evening unless cancelled due to inclement weather OR under special circumstances, and with the approval of the opposing players and the Game Committee, games can be rescheduled. The Games Director or the Greens Keeper will advise players if the games are cancelled due to inclement weather. Notification will be posted on the website and/or participants will be notified

by email at the earliest opportunity. Any games that are cancelled will need to be made up prior to the next schedule games.

13. The league coordinator will determine the prize distribution at the end of the schedule.
