CONDITIONS OF PLAY

The Laws of the Sport Crystal Mark 4th Edition 2022 Edition will be followed with the following additions:

1. Dress will be casual.
2. The games will be 14 ends.
3. Each player will deliver four bowls.
4. Scoring will be – 3 points for a win, 0 points for a loss and 1 point for a tie. The team with the highest points after 4 weeks will be declared a winner. Ties will be broken by shot differential +/- . If still tied by ends won.
5. Over the 4 weeks, each player may use a spare for 1 week. A spare may not play the position of Skip.
6. The position of Skip can only be changed on a weekly basis (not during a game).
7. If the Jack is improperly delivered once by both teams, it is placed 2 metres from the front ditch and on the centre line (also known as the T).
8. If the jack in motion passes completely outside the boundaries of the rink of play, or rebounds to a distance of less than 18 metres from the mat line, the end should not be declared dead. Instead, the jack must be re-spotted according to the one re-spot position (Law 56.5.2.3 - also known as the T) and the game continues.
9. Restricting Movement: Leads can only walk up to the head after their third and fourth bowl, skips after delivery of each of their bowls.
10. Score cards are to be initialed by each skip and returned to sunroom to allow for the Games Committee to update the standings. The updated standings will be posted on the Games board and on the Club calendar.
11. Games must be played on the scheduled evening unless cancelled due to inclement weather OR under special circumstances, and with the approval of the opposing team and the Game Committee, games can be rescheduled. The Games Director or the Greens Keeper will advise players if the games are cancelled due to inclement weather. Notification will be posted on the website and/or participants will be notified by email at the earliest opportunity. Any games that are cancelled will need to be made up prior to the next schedule games.
12. Any team that is not ready to bowl by 10 minutes after the scheduled start time will default the game. The non-defaulting team will be awarded 3 points and receiving the average for ends won and shots for and against from the other teams playing that day.

13. The league coordinator will determine the prize distribution at the end of the schedule.
