

ANY GENDER TRIPLES. WEDNESDAY MORNING SUMMER LEAGUE

- 5 games played July 8th to August 6th 2026 at 9:30 am
- On line registration required. Registration opens on June 23rd and closes on July 2nd or when 48 player entries are received.
- Register as an individual, open to all members.

CONDITIONS OF PLAY

Games will be played in line with the Laws of the Sport of Bowls. Crystal Mark 4th Edition

Setting Teams

After registration has closed Players will be divided into 3 equal sized groups by the Games Committee. One group of skips, another group of thirds and another group of leads. Each players draw tag will be the primary guideline in which group they will be in, but there will likely be a need for adjustments to get the same number of players in each group.

The Games Committee will form teams of Triples prior to Game 1 with a player from each group on all teams. The team composition is fixed for all five games, (unless substitute players are needed).

Each team will draw a rink number at Game 1, which will set their rinks and opponents for all 5 games, automatically.

The Game

Each game is a triples game, 3 bowls per player. **12 ends** will be played. No trial ends.

The one spot re-spot rule on the 2 metre mark will apply if the jack is pushed out of bounds during any end.

Leads may not visit the head until after both leads have delivered all 3 of their bowls. Thirds and Skips may visit the head when they have rink possession but only after their second bowls.

For games 2 to 5, players may not practice on the rink they are assigned for this league on that day. If they are assigned to that rink for a league or draw earlier that day, that is acceptable.

Scoring

Both skips shall keep score on the provided score cards. On completion of the game, score cards are to be verified by each skip, initialed by each skip and returned to the sunroom to allow for the Games Committee to update the standings.

3 points for a win, 1 point for a tie and 0 points for a loss. Teams will be ranked, first by game points, then by shot differential, with a limit in each game of a 10 shot differential, and if still tied by shots for divided by shots against.

The updated standings will be posted on the Games board and on the Club calendar.

Rearranging Games and Substitute Players

In the event that any players are unable to play in a game, that team may ask their opponents to reschedule the game, **the rescheduled game must be played before the next regularly scheduled game.** The opponents may decline the request to reschedule, in which case the team who requested the reschedule may either:

- Arrange for substitute players, to play in their place at the scheduled date and time. The substitute's tag on the draw board, must be no higher than that of the player they are replacing. There is no limit to the number of times a player gets a substitute to play for them,
- Or, forfeit the game by the average score in all other games played in that round.

Entry Fee and Prizes

Entry fee is \$5 per player, payable at the first game.

The highest ranked team will each win a personalized bag tag.

Any remaining funds will be distributed as prizes.
