Game#2 will **start at 1:00PM** and both Clubs will provide players for 4 games each of;

- Mixed Pairs (8 players) on 4 greens
- Mixed Triples (12 players) on 4 greens

There are two **Team Captains** per Club – PLBC **Women's - Sandi Mitchel** & PLBC **Men's – Bob Merrell**. Team Captains will work together to select players for the positions available in Games #1 & 2.
