CONDITIONS OF PLAY

The Laws of the Sport Crystal Mark 4th Edition 2022 Edition will be followed with the following exceptions:

1. The Conditions of Play for Tournaments as posted in the clubhouse will apply.
 2. Dress will smart casual - with the exception of red which is reserved for umpires.
 3. Games will be of 2 – 7 end sets.
 4. There are trial ends before the first game both days, 2 bowls up, 2 bowls back.
 5. All games will start with a bell. There is no time limit.
 6. Points: 1 point is awarded for each Set won. ½ point is awarded for each Set tied. 3 Points are awarded for each Game won.
 7. Tournament winners to be determined by total game points, if tied then total sets points, if still tied shot differential.
 8. If the game is tied after two Sets a 3-end tie breaker will be played to decide the winner, coin toss to determine possession of the mat. If tied after 3 ends, a final tie breaker will be played. Coin toss to determine possession of the mat.
 9. Restricting Movement: players will be able to visit the head after they have thrown their third and fourth bowls.
 10. Improper delivery of the jack: If the jack has been improperly delivered once by both teams, it is placed 2 metres from the front ditch and on the centre line.
 11. If the jack is driven outside the boundary of the rink, the end is not dead, and the jack will be re-spotted on the One re-spot position two meters from the front ditch.
 12. If the marker is doing the measuring he/she may ask for assistance from one of the players or call the umpire as the marker sees fit.
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PLEASE NOTE AND RESPECT THE FOLLOWING RULES AND
OTHER HOUSEKEEPING ITEMS
OF PARKSVILLE LAWN BOWLING CLUB

1. Spectators may sit on the deck, by the flag pole near the entrance to the Club or on the upper bank. Spectators are not permitted to sit or stand within the field of play.
2. Smoking of anything is not permitted anywhere on the grounds of the Parksville Lawn Bowling Club.
3. No alcohol consumption may take place with the exception of inside the Clubhouse in the main seating area and on the deck of the Clubhouse.
4. Dogs are only permitted to sit on the upper bank must remain under control at all times.
5. Please silence all communication devices.
6. An AED is located in the white First Aid cupboard in the Clubhouse.
