CONDITIONS OF PLAY

The Laws of the Sport Crystal Mark 4th Edition 2022 Edition will be followed with the following exceptions:

1. The Conditions of Play for All Open Tournaments as posted in the clubhouse will apply.
2. Dress will be smart casual.
3. Teams and rinks will be drawn before the start of the first game. Skips will draw tags for their Thirds and Leads as well as their rinks. (Team of Chance.)
4. Each team will play four – 12 end games for the Triples portion of the Tournament. Scoring is 3 points for a win, 1 for a tie and 0 for a loss. Winners will be determined by game points. If there is a tie; then by ends won, and if still tied then by shot differential +/-10 per game.
5. The top 3 men's teams and top 3 ladies' teams from the Triples Tournament will play a further 5 end game to determine the winner of the Battle of the Sexes. The first-place teams will play each other, the second-place teams will play each other and the third-place teams will play each other. Rinks will be drawn prior to the start of the 5 end games. The winner of the Battle of the Sexes will be determined by whichever of the genders has the highest number of total shots.
6. There will be trial ends before the first game each morning, 2 bowls up and 2 bowls back for each player.
7. Each game will start with a bell. The bell will ring again after two hours – no new ends may commence after the bell except in the case of an improperly delivered jack.
8. Improper delivery of the jack: If the jack has been improperly delivered once by both teams, it is placed 2 meters from the front ditch and on the centre line.
9. If the jack in motion passes completely outside the boundaries of the rink of play, or rebounds to a distance of less than 18 metres from the mat line, the end should not be declared dead. Instead, the jack must be re-spotted according to one re-spot position (Law 56.5.2.3) and the game continues.
10. Restricting Movement: Leads can only walk up to the head after their third bowl, thirds after their second and third bowls and skips after delivery of each of their bowls.
11. Each score card should be initialed by each skip and returned to the draw table by the winning skip at the end of each game.
12. If a substitute is required the person being replaced will not be able to reenter the tournament, except under special circumstances as determined by the Controlling Body of Parksville Lawn Bowling Club. The Substitute must be the same gender as the player being replaced.
13. There are no umpires for the event.

**PLEASE NOTE AND RESPECT THE FOLLOWING RULES AND
OTHER HOUSEKEEPING ITEMS
OF PARKSVILLE LAWN BOWLING CLUB**

1. Spectators may sit on the deck or on the upper bank. Spectators are not permitted to sit or stand within the field of play.
2. Alcohol may only be consumed inside the Clubhouse in the main seating area and on the deck of the Clubhouse.
3. Smoking of anything is not permitted anywhere on the grounds of the Parksville Lawn Bowling Club.
4. Dogs are only permitted on the upper bank and must remain under control.
5. Please silence all communication devices.
6. An AED is located in the white First Aid cupboard in the Clubhouse.
